The more observant amongst you may have noticed that Mrs Leech has been glowing lately! We can confirm that Hannah is indeed expecting a baby that is due in early March.

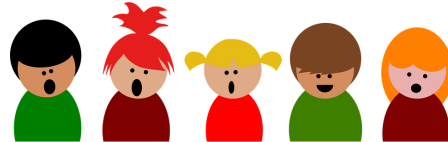
We will be advertising next week to find a skilled Reception teacher from February.

YEAR 1

Next week Year 1 will be expanding their vocabulary in Literacy, and using the suffix 'er.' In maths they will be completing reviews. In RE they will begin looking at The Christmas Story in the Bible, and will continue making objects that have simple mechanisms; pop-ups, levers etc. in DT. In Science the children are 'sensing seasons' and will conclude their understanding on Autumn.

We are currently having an issue with our class page and some parents are having trouble accessing the Learning Log, therefore we have sent a paper copy home with your child today. We have also included a 100% sheet which gives your child facts about their current topic and is designed to improve their general knowledge.

In Y1 the children are challenged to complete number bond cards (number bonds to 10) and then move on to times tables cards so please practise these maths skills with them a little and often. They can also do the 10 book reading challenge where they can earn a star badge- just like our Literacy focus character Zog!

YEAR 2

Another busy week! We are learning our songs for the Nativity. Please help your child to learn the script that has been sent home.

In Maths the children will be using their skills in multiplication and applying their knowledge to problem solving. In English we will continue to look at Traditional tales with a twist. The children will focus on the structure of a story and using this to help them plan their own twisted tale.

In Science we are exploring how to keep healthy, this week we will look at how we change as we grow as well as plan and carry out an investigation. In Re it will be our last session exploring special books.
