## Safer Internet Day 2019 - Tuesday 5th February

Our children have never known a world without the internet - it is part of their world and one which brings amazing sights and experiences to their fingertips. School and families need to teach them how to operate safely in that cyber world; it is just as important as teaching them to cross the road, use a knife and fork safely and put on a sunhat in the real world!

**We work throughout the 7 years here to embed the basic online safety lessons such as:**

- Don't post any personal information online – like your address, email address or mobile number.
- Keep your privacy settings as high as possible
- Never give out your passwords
- Don't befriend people you don't know
- Don't meet up with people you've met online. Speak to your parent or carer about people suggesting you do
- Remember that not everyone online is who they say they are
- Think carefully about what you say before you post something online
- Respect other people's views, even if you don't agree with someone else's views doesn't mean you need to be rude
- If you see something online that makes you feel uncomfortable, unsafe or worried: leave the website, turn off your computer and tell a trusted adult immediately.
- Think carefully before posting pictures or videos of yourself or others. Once you've put a picture of yourself online most people can see it and may be able to download it, it's not just yours anymore.

Our online safety curriculum is updated regularly as the cyber world they operate in changes.
