## Absences

This week we have been made aware of a number of children whose parents have notified us of absence through illness but school has been informed, either by the children themselves or by others, that they have been absent for day trips or holidays. Your child must be in school everyday they are fit and we should have an honest explanation if they are absent. We now need to routinely ask for sight of appointment cards for dental or hospital visits. Requests for holidays must be in writing - and whilst we can authorise very rarely, it is still important for school to know the reason your child is absent a) for our records and b) so your child is not put in the awful position of having to be dishonest to the people that they need to trust. Teaching your child that it is OK to lie to school damages the relationship they have with us and the relationship we have with you. It also teaches your child that education isn't important and that being reliable and honest are not important values.
